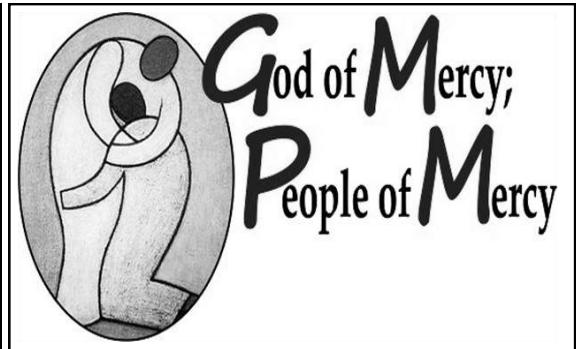

Fr. Joe Writes...

It's nice to be back again after the holidays and I am most grateful for the warm welcome. I spent most of the time in Donegal, but the first week was overshadowed by the sudden death of my cousin Seamus McGeady which caused shock waves far beyond the family and parish community. I also made a trip down to Limerick for the funeral of Alice Hennessy, the aunt of Fr Pat Hennessy, who died peacefully at the age of 92. On the way back we called in to the shrine of Knock and we were struck by the peaceful serenity of the place where a remarkable apparition took place in 1879, lasting two hours, and witnessed by 15 people of various ages. The Lamb was central to the vision and to the side stood Mary, Mother and Queen, flanked by St Joseph and St John the evangelist. It was well worth the visit.

Many thanks to Fr Willy Slavin, who covered the 3 Sundays, and to Fr Donnelly and Mgr Docherty who covered the weekdays. I have extra reason for hoping and praying that they keep in good health for a long time to come!

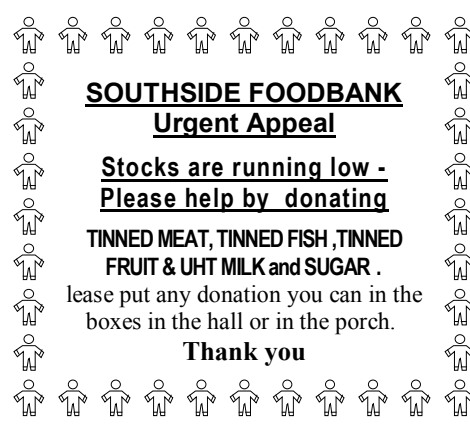
Prayer cards are available to encourage us to pray for the success of the project. With the help of God and the prayers of Mary all may realise that we are the children of God and precious in the sight of God.
