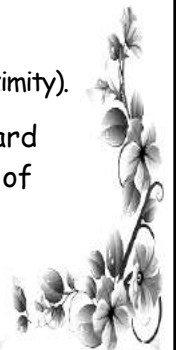
For use in homes is available at the back of the church beside the shrine to the Sacred Heart.

The priest who signs the card takes on the responsibility of ensuring, as well as he can, that the Mass is said by himself or another priest in good standing.

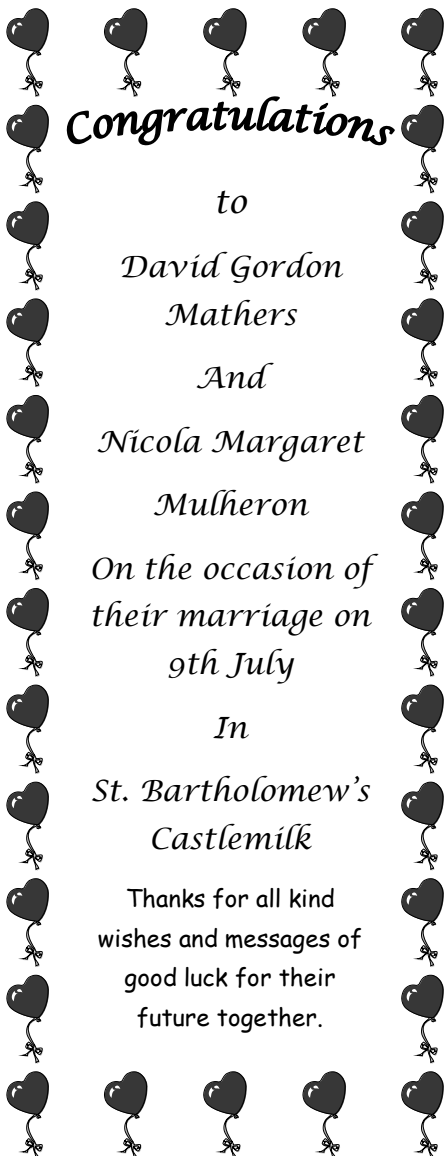
